Forest Schools Day

As you may be aware, on Monday 20th June children will be taking part in our second Forest Schools activity day led by one of our parents, Amy Exeter, who is a fully qualified forest schools instructor.

During the morning session, children will be accessing a wooded area, a short walk from school, to take part in a minibeast hunt and bug hotel building. We will then be returning to school before lunchtime. In the afternoon, children will be accessing the nature area opposite school to continue their investigations of minibeasts and their habitats.

Children do not need to wear school uniform on the day, however, they will need to be dressed appropriately for changeable weather conditions. Children will need to bring a pair of wellies no matter the weather as the area of the woods we are using can be quite boggy. If we are lucky enough to get another period of warm weather, please apply sun cream to your child and provide them with a sun hat.

The children thoroughly enjoyed our last forest schools day and we are sure that Monday will be an equally exciting day!
