

Cool Milk

All children here have been receiving milk from school this half-term while we waited for our registration with the 'Cool Milk' scheme to progress. This registration is now active, so from **Monday 2nd November** we will no longer be offering free school milk to children aged 5 and over.

All children under the age of 5 are entitled to free school milk and are automatically registered with 'Cool Milk'. They will continue to receive free milk until their 5th birthday.

Children aged 5 and over are not entitled to free school milk, but can receive subsidised milk if parents would like to sign up to the scheme. This can be done online at www.coolmilk.com.
