Traffic and Parking

Please note, we have had a number of complaints from local residents to the school, the local authority and police in regards to parking and dangerous driving. As a result, Cleveland Police have indicated they will be around school over the next few weeks at busy times of the day.

As always, maintaining a safe environment is our prime aim - I would like to point out a few things that could minimise the risk to the safety of residents, parents and especially children from 'inconsiderate' parking. Please:

- do not park on the yellow lines outside of school;
- keep pedestrian crossings clear on the main road and in Blackwood, especially those paths that cross junctions;
- don't block paths when bumping up on pavements and avoid double-parking;
- avoid doing 3-point turns – Wynyard Woods is one continual loop with access to the main road at both ends.

We are currently working with the developer next to school to create a 25-bay temporary car park for parents with the aim of making parking a little easier and will update you on the progress of this soon.
