Extension to the Temporary Site

All of the work to extend the temporary school site has now been completed. We are very pleased with the space created with the new layout. School is now effectively separated into three areas, each with its own yard:

- Nursery
- Early Years/Key Stage 1
- Key Stage 2

We also have a dedicated access to nursery with the creation of a path to the left of the staff car park.
