

Wynyard Spelling Bee 2019!



Will you be your class or even the school spelling champion?

During the week beginning Monday 29th April , we will once again be holding our successful Wynyard Spelling Bee competition!

During the Easter holidays and the following week, please learn the spellings for your year group, which are attached and available on the school website, to prepare yourself for the class heats before the final takes place on Friday 3rd May. (Please note, Years 1 and 2 should try to learn the words for both year groups).

During the spelling bee, you will be given a word from your list, followed by a sentence placing it in context and then the word will be repeated. You should then try and spell the word, clearly saying each letter. If you spell the word correctly, you remain in the spelling bee, continuing to spell words until we find our spelling champions.

Everyone who takes part will receive a certificate and there is a trophy for the spelling champion in each class as well as a Grand prize for our overall Spelling Bee champion!

You do not have to take part in the Spelling Bee but please try to learn the spellings— you might even change your mind about entering.

Remember, there are lots of creative words to learn your spellings— you could try writing the **letters** in different colours or make up acrostics to help you remember trickier words. A great way to practise is to use Spelling Shed, our new online re-source.
