

Homework

Children in Year 2 will continue to receive weekly homework. It will be sent home on a Friday and we ask that it is completed and returned no later than Wednesday. This allows us to mark the work and stick new homework in.

Each week your child will receive:

- A piece of English Homework
- A piece of Maths Homework
- A list of spellings (tested fortnightly on Friday)
- A reading book appropriate to your child's reading ability – to be changed twice per week. (As well as word recognition, a key focus on home reading should also be comprehension.)
If you listen to your child read, could you please question them about what they've read to build up their comprehension skills? They will complete tests in Reading (in addition to Maths and Spelling, punctuation and grammar) during the week beginning **20th May**.

Please ensure that reading records and reading books are brought into school every day. Children could read with an adult on any day during the week during guided reading sessions and comments are recorded in reading records. In addition to the homework, we ask that you encourage your child to read as much as they can at home either independently or by sharing a book with an adult. They can also use Bug Club (logins can be found on the front page of reading records. Please sign and comment so that we can see how children are doing at home. Thank you for your continued support.

Dear Parents,


I hope you all had a wonderful Easter break, the Summer term is finally upon us, how the year has flown!

SATs tests will take place over 2 weeks. They will be carried out in small groups in the week beginning **Monday 20th May** and tests will take place on mornings only.

Please make sure that children get plenty of rest the night before the tests take place so that they come to school ready and eager to learn as always. Any questions, don't hesitate to ask.

Please make sure that your child still comes to school each day with a coat. Whilst I know we are now in the Summer term, we all know how unpredictable the British weather can be and even if the weather is pleasant when children are preparing to come to school, it can get colder throughout the day. Let's hope for lots of sunshine!
