

Flu Immunisations

A reminder to parents, the school nurse will be in school on Wednesday 25th November to administer nasal spray flu vaccinations. We have had a number of parents visiting the school office to register their child. Unfortunately, we are not able to register children for the vaccination through the office and parents must register via the link. We have attached the form from the School Nursing Team again which contains the link for parents to give consent for their child to receive the vaccine. Please note, they can only administer vaccines to children who have had consent. **There is also an option to opt out on the link for those who do not give consent.** This is a government scheme for children from Reception to Year 6 (unfortunately, Nursery are not eligible).

Forest Schools

On Wednesday 7th October it will be Year 2's turn to take part in an educational forest school lesson. Class 6 will have their session in the morning and Class 5 in the afternoon. **Children can come to school in their forest school clothes.** Please ensure they have a waterproof coat/suitable footwear.

This incident has been reported to the police so we ask you all to keep your eye out for anything that may have been "dumped" around Wynyard Village and let us know if you have heard or seen anything.
