### Lateral Flow Tests

After a few questions from parents, we have sought further guidance from Public Health England around the use of lateral flow tests for children. PHE's guidance is that, at this stage, results from lateral flow tests administered to children of primary school age cannot be accepted for either asymptomatic or symptomatic children. If your child does develop any of the Coronavirus symptoms, you will need to book a PCR test for them and the whole household will need to self-isolate until the results are received.
