

## Spring Term After School Clubs

After being overwhelmed by demand for places for clubs in September and, having taken on board feedback from parents, we have decided to make some changes to our booking system for after school clubs for January.

In order to ensure all children have the opportunity to attend after school clubs, parents will, initially, be limited to signing up to 2 clubs per child, with the option to sign up to any remaining places later.

We have also reviewed the time our booking system goes live as we know previously it has been difficult for some parents to access the system during the working day.

The booking system for clubs starting in January will open at 7pm on Thursday 9th December using our online system:

At this point, parents will be able to sign up for 2 clubs per child (on a first come first serve basis). On Monday 13th December at 8pm, the limit will be removed and any remaining spaces for clubs will be made available so parents can sign up for additional clubs, if spaces are available.
