

Road Safety and Cycle Path

We appreciate your patience as everyone has been adjusting to our new flexible drop-off time as result of government guidance. We are very lucky at Wynyard to have a parent/carer carpark and drop-off bays; however, like all schools, we experience heavy traffic at key pick-up and drop-off times. We have continued to contact the local authority to seek support with some of the issues that parents have reported, including the use of mobile phones whilst driving. Should you have any significant concerns, we would encourage you to report them to the relevant authorities.

We would continue to encourage parents/ carers and children to cycle, scooter or walk to school. Please be aware, the path into school is separated into pedestrian and cycle lanes, so we ask that you remain aware of these when entering the site.
